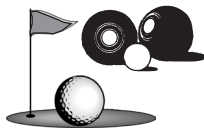
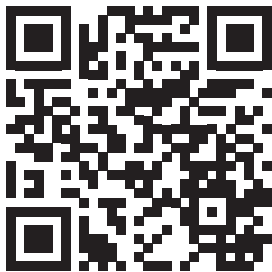

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS:

3 rounds of stroke. Best gross aggregate deciding winner of A, B, C and D Grades, as well as Senior Champion (aged 55 years and above). Also 54 holes net trophies given. A player commencing championships in one particular grade shall remain in that grade for the duration of championships.

Trophies will be given out for each round using normal ball comp. A player whose handicap changes during the course of championship shall have his nett daily scores off his current handicap recorded for the 54 holes nett trophy. Ties in gross events shall be decided by sudden death play off.

Grades to be calculated to be as even as possible.

The top four leaders in each grade, after two rounds, are required to play together for the final round, at the allotted time decided upon by the committee.

JACK ROCHE 4BALL KNOCKOUT:

Two completed qualifying rounds of 4Ball Best Ball Bogey from which top 12 pairs will continue in 4BBB Matchplay.

SINGLES KNOCKOUT:

To be entered via the sheet on the noticeboard. A random draw shall be conducted and there will be four weeks to play each match.

KNOCKOUT MATCHES:

In all knockout matches, eg: Jack Roche 4ball, Singles Knockout Matchplay, matches are to be played on the set date with hit off times between 12pm and 1.30pm (the only exception to this is that by mutual

Please note: Check set dates before entering these events.

STABLEFORD TROPHY:

Six rounds of Stableford of which the best four rounds count. The player with the highest best four round points total shall be the winner.

ECLECTIC:

All events marked (E) on the syllabus. 18 hole aggregate of best score on each hole over these events, less ½ handicap.

MONTHLY MEDAL:

Stroke round from white marks. The player having the best scratch score on the day will receive one ball.

CAPTAINS PUTTER – Sponsored by Edge Print:

Four rounds of stroke play of which the best three rounds count. The player with the lowest aggregate of their three rounds shall be the winner.

STAR MEDAL:

Winners of the 12 monthly medals are eligible to play in this 18 hole stroke round. The lowest nett round of the 12 competitors shall be the winner of the star medal.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR AND JUNIOR TROPHY:

Points are awarded for various events throughout the year with the player with the highest points score at the end of the winter season being the winner. Junior Trophy as per Player of the year.

HANDICAP:

Each player to be eligible to enter any club event (Chicken Runs excepted) shall have a current Australian Handicap. For players to obtain Aust Handicap, they must submit three cards to the professional.

VISITORS:

To be able to play in club events, visitors must pay ½ green fees and competition fees. A visitor cannot win a major club trophy (eg Monthly Medal).

HOLE IN ONE – Sponsored by Kevin Hicks Real Estate

Any golfer playing in a recognised open or club event, including pennant, shall be eligible to (1) have their name recorded on the club hole-in-one honour board and receive a trophy. (2) In addition, any Numurkah Golf Club member shall receive a \$100 club voucher.

EAGLES NEST- J. Dell Sponsor

One ball each Saturday will be added to the nest. Any player in the Saturday competition can win the nest and, if multiple eagles occur on the same day, the nest will be shared (excludes hole in one).

CROW'S NEST - Sponsored by Titleist and Srixon

Crow's Nest on the 7th Hole (sponsored by Titleist) and the 18th hole (sponsored by Srixon) will be awarded to any club member hitting their tee shot within one metre from the hole. Applicable for all Saturday club competitions.

MATCH COMMITTEE:

The match committee shall have the power to settle any dispute or alter any event as they see fit.

TEeing AREA:

The white tee markers are to be used for all competition events. Social golf will be played from the yellow markers.

TIES IN FEATURE EVENTS:

Captains Putter: delete worst score of the three that count towards final total, then next worst if required and so on until tie is broken.

Stableford Trophy: delete worst score of the four that count towards final total, then next worst if required, and so on until the tie is broken.

Eclectic: Normal countback

Championships (Scr): Sudden death playoff

Championships (Hcap): Normal countback procedure on the last round.

Chicken Run Bag: Delete worst score

HEAT POLICY:

If at 12 noon, the day preceding the competition, the forecast for the following day is 40 degrees Celsius or higher on the Elders Weather smartphone app, the Heat Policy timesheet will come into effect and the latest tee time will be 10am. Further details regarding the heat policy are given in the pages following.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR POINTS SYSTEM

Runs from opening day of season until closing day of winter season. Points are allocated as described below:

Club Championships scratch and nett, Jack Roche Fourball, Singles Knockout, Captain's Putter Overall, Stableford Trophy Overall
1st/Winner = 35 pts, 2nd /R'Up = 20 pts, 3rd /Semi Finalist = 10 pts,
4th/Qtr Finalist = 5pts, 5th = 3pts

Monthly Medal Daily Comps and Eclectic Overall

1st = 15 pts, 2nd = 10 pts, 3rd = 6 pts, 4th = 4 pts, 5th = 2pts

Standard Comps marked (E)

1st = 10 pts, 2nd = 5 pts, 3rd = 3 pts, 4th = 2 pts, 5th = 1 pt

Inclement Weather Policy - Adopted by the Board February 28th 2023

Policy Statement

The Board of Numurkah Golf & Bowls Club Inc recognises its responsibility in offering advice to members and visitors regarding risks associated with playing sports during periods of inclement weather. It has therefore adopted this policy.

Players Responsibility:

All players need to be consciously aware of the dangers of adverse and extreme weather, storm and lightning conditions while on the golf course or bowling greens. It is the players responsibility to make a conscious decision during these conditions to stop play, come off the golf course or bowling greens and seek safe shelter. If caught in these weather conditions. It is then the players responsibility to advise the Clubhouse Staff or Club Professional of their suspension of end of play based on the decision.

Golf Australia advises the responsibility of players to make safe decisions during potentially dangerous weather conditions by checking weather apps or the BOM (Bureau of Meteorology) website. This is relevant to both Golf and Bowls participants.

The Clubs Responsibility is to advise players of actions to mitigate risk

As a guideline, we recommend all players do the following in the interest of their own safety:

- Put down your umbrella
- Golfers place your clubs back in your bag or cart, avoid holding or touching them.
- Keep clear of any tree lines
- Remove yourself from the open course or bowling greens by returning to the clubhouse or seeking safe shelter nearby.
- Golfers vacate golf carts; these will not protect you from lightning or dangerous weather.
- Shelter, remember open structures are not considered safe; an enclosed building is the safest option.
- If taking shelter in a building structure or vehicle, please ensure doors and windows are closed and avoid touching anything that may conduct electricity.
- 30/30 Rule; by the time the flash-to-bang count is 30 seconds, you should be in a safe location, and you shouldn't resume any activity until 30 minutes after the last thunder is heard.

Suspension or cancellation of club events:

The person responsible for suspending or cancelling club competitions or events due to inclement weather will be:

The Golf Pro / Sports Manager. If unavailable, this responsibility will transfer to:

The Golf Captains (OR Bowls Manager if a bowls event only). If unavailable, this responsibility will transfer to:

The President or most senior Board member. If unavailable, this responsibility will transfer to:

The most senior member of the match committee. If unavailable, this responsibility will transfer to:

The Duty Manager.

Suspension or cancellation of play for non-club events (social play):

The person responsible for suspending or cancelling non-club competitions or events due to inclement weather will be:

The Golf Pro / Sports Manager. If unavailable, this responsibility will transfer to:

The Duty Manager

Communicating suspension or cancellation of play

In the first instance, an air horn will be sounded from the clubhouse, upon hearing players should return immediately to the clubhouse if no risk is apparent. If it is identified players are still on the golf course and if there is no apparent risk, the person suspending play will travel in a cart or by other means to inform players. If a risk that travelling on the course is identified, attempts will be made to contact players by mobile phone.

Heat Policy (Golf) – Adopted by the Board March 3rd 2026

With recommendations from Golf Victoria's Heat Policy and consultation with the clubs Health & Safety representative, the golf match committees have implemented the following policy in relation to playing golf in heat related conditions.

If at 12 noon, the day preceding the competition, the forecast for the following day is 40 degrees or higher the Heat Policy timesheet will come into effect.

No player in a club competition and/ or social play shall hit off after 10.00am.

In the event of **extreme heat**, where a “**catastrophic**” forecast is issued, the **course will be closed for all play**.

*The temperature will be based on the B.O.M Weather website for Numurkah

The Board would also like to advise persons playing in club competitions on hot days to read the following information

Any player, caddy or official with a pre-existing physical or medical condition; or illness, which may exacerbate the risk of heat illness, should take every precaution or consider excluding themselves from participation during hot weather conditions.

Numurkah Golf Club assumes no responsibility for any medical situation in relation to a competitor who experiences the applicable below conditions. It is recommended that competitors with a pre-existing medical condition and/or illness consult a medical practitioner for advice prior to playing golf in hot conditions.

Examples of medical conditions which should exclude a player from participating due to an increased risk of heat illness include asthma, diabetes, pregnancy, heart conditions or epilepsy, or anyone experiencing a high temperature, viral infection, and diarrhea or vomiting. Some medications and conditions may require special allowances (such as the use of motorised carts).

All players should wear a hat and sunscreen and carry plenty of water.
